Catie is a modern day Austen's Emma. She's Katie from *What Katie Did Next*, she's Tracy Lord from *The Philadelphia Story*, she's Bridget Jones, she's Becky Bloomwood from the *Shopaholic* series. And yet, she has an unmistakable voice and a distinct identity of her own. She's headstrong, funny, disarmingly honest, sweetly naive and you find yourself rooting for her through it all. The strong supporting cast round out this charming tale. I read this novel on a plane ride and found myself chuckling constantly. I gave it to my sister, a mom of three, who barely has time to get through a magazine, let alone a novel, and she polished it off in a weekend. Frothy chick-lit? Certainly. But of the very best kind, whipped up into the most delectable of concoctions. A solid assured new voice on the scene, I am eager to see *What Brooke Stanton Does Next*.

I am yet again reminded of why I do not gravitate toward romantic books. They all feel exactly the same to me. Maybe I just haven't been reading the right ones? This was a sweet story. I'd say this is one of those easy reads for summer when you do not want a heavy or complex story. The plot, like I said, felt very familiar, and I guess this distracted me a lot.
