

While this is generally true, "A People Who Would Not Kneel" documents how the Kuna of Panama were able to avoid that fate. It is loaded with archival photos and is aimed towards the layperson. I won't disclose the causes of how the Kuna were able to maintain a degree of independence unrivaled in the Americas, other than to say that an American adventurer and a quirk of genetics were instrumental.
